



## STATE ABBREVIATIONS

### State Abbreviations for Publication Place

According to AACR2, 2002 edition, Appendix B-8 to B-9, section B.14, use the following expanded state names:

- As additions to names of certain corporate bodies;
- As additions to the name of the place of publication or distribution in the publications area (260 field, subfield a);
- In notes.

All states are to be spelled out in the bibliographic record.

Do not use US postal code abbreviations for the states in the 260 \$a field.

Do not abbreviate the name of a city or town even if it has the same name as a state, e.g., *Washington, D.C.* not *Wash., D.C.* Do not abbreviate any place name.
