Auto-Graphics (AG) offers two methods for searching OCLC. One method is Z39.50 accessed through AG software. Z39.50 uses the cataloger's AG login. The second method uses OCLC Connexion client software which is Windows-based and is downloaded from OCLC onto the catalogers' computer. Catalogers login to the Connexion client software to download bibliographic records from OCLC for adding to LMN's database.

Each method has its' pros and cons.

Z39.50 – OCLC calls its' Z39.50 OLUCWorldCat (OLUC) in AG. There is no separate login and is accessible directly from AG. When using OLUC, it is difficult to determine WHICH bib is best because while the icons help identify the material type, there are no holdings information and no indications of being in a foreign language, and the level of cataloging, etc. Each bib record must be opened to find the best match which is time consuming. Also, catalogers must watch intently which database is being used. The OLUC location is no longer searching LMN.

Connexion - Logging into OCLC Connexion is the preferred way allowing for more accurate and "best" bib records from which to select. If these are only a few selections, the list will appear including the author, title, publisher, date, 300 field, OCLC #, and number of holdings. Usually the bib with the most holdings is the better bib record. If there are many selections, the list will appear differently. Usually, the bib with the "D" in the L-column is the best bib record.

PROCEDURE

~Search LMN first to determine if a bib record exists by ISBN, title/author, etc. There does not need to be duplicate bib records in the LMN database.

~For items not in LMN, search OCLC.

~Create item records for bib records.

Bib records from OCLC added to LMN's catalog will be indexed by AG either that night or on Friday.

The procedural flow is as follows:



LOCATION CODES

Each member library has a unique login provided by LMN to access OCLC. (The state library provides for the public libraries' access)

OCLC uses separate location code symbols:

LMN LOCATION	OCLC LOCATION CODE

After the code symbol, OCLC uses standard codes for the following divisions:

- A Adult
- B Juvenile
- C Audio-visual
- E Reference

For example: MWQC would be an audio-visual item at Gadsden State.

EDITING BIB RECORDS IN OCLC

Bib records are not edited in OCLC. Bib records are edited AFTER being added to LMN.

Make changes as required by LMN's Cataloging Procedural Manual:

- ~ Remove surplus fields (no 019, 029, 040, 776, 9xx)
- ~ Remove duplicate 6xx fields (remove indicator 7 keep 655 7)
- ~ spell out 020 suffix information (paperback/hardcover/etc.) and 300 info (pages/color/illustrations/etc.)

This bib is missing the OCLC # in 035 field and other data. We need to see if there is a better record from OCLC to use.

This is very time consuming and confusing because after 3 to 5 records, catalogers will have to make written notes on which record is best/unique. They are not numbered or evaluated, so that makes it more confusing. For this title, there are two separate books; one that is 1492 -2001 and one that is 1492 to present. From this display, one cannot even tell the difference using Z39.50.

Conscientious objectors, Britten and Pears followed Auden to America before the war began in 1939. While there, they joined the extraordinary Brooklyn ménage of George Davis, Louis MacNeice, and Paul Bowles. Eventually intense homesickness, provoked in part by George Crabbe's poem "Peter Grimes," drove the pair home to East Anglia in 1942 and gave Britten the inspiration for his finest opera. Throughout his career, Britten did not want modern music to be just for "the cultured few" and instead always composed his music to be "listenable to."
